(the highest level of achievement for heavy weaponry fighting)

Member of the Order of the Pelican

(the highest level of achievement for service to the society)

The Nobility

Baron / Baroness

(current leader of a Barony) OR (has been made a “court”

Baron/Baroness by a king & queen)

(recognition of high merit)

When talking about them: “The Honorable Lord/Lady Fullname”
